## The Construction Industry Labour Relations Amendment Act

Hon. Rob Norris, Minister of Advanced Education, Employment and Labour on behalf of the Provincial Government introduced Bill 80, an *Act to Amend The Construction Industry Labour Relations Act*.

The amendments will:

- √ Provide **greater choice for employees** to choose the union they want to represent them
- √ **Allow for greater competition**, ensuring employee wages remain competitive
- √ **Build the construction industry's capacity** to meet the demands of the province's growing economy
- √ **Bring about stability and growth** in the construction industry and pave the way for greater investment and jobs across our province
- √ Attract **more skilled labour** and more construction companies to the province
- √ Authorize the Labour Relations Board to **decertify old, abandoned union agreements**, just like other provinces across Canada
- √ **Allow workers to choose** trade or craft specific agreements or "wall to wall" bargaining unions to represent them

The Provincial Government has shown strong leadership by improving our labour relations climate with Bill 80. Let's keep the momentum going!
